## **Hindawi signs publishing partnership agreement with American Association for the Advancement of Science**

LONDON: Hindawi today announced the signing of a publishing partnership agreement with the American Association for the Advancement of Science (AAAS). Hindawi will support AAAS by providing post-acceptance publishing services for AAAS's new *Science* Partner Journal publishing program. AAAS anticipates its first partner journal will launch in early 2018.

The *Science* Partner Journals will use Hindawi's systems, processes, and staff for the management of accepted manuscripts during the production phase. A new journal platform will also be created to host the published articles. All articles published in the journal will be fully Open Access, using a Creative Commons attribution license (CC-BY 4.0).
